

Hakim Mamoni, CTO of Coinsilium

- Our CTO, Hakim is the tech-head in the team, a software programmer and well-regarded speaker in the global bitcoin and crypto community.
- He co-founded Seedcoin which launched in July 2013 and by the end of March 2014 had invested in six startups.
- Hakim had his bitcoin epiphany in 2012 while living in China. It is a testament to his foresight when you look at the success of bitcoin in the region, a few years on.
- A graduate from the ENSAE in Paris, Hakim has a mixed background in science, finance and economy. He started his work career on trading floors in Paris and in the City of London in the early 90's where he coded FinTech apps long before the word FinTech had entered the Lexicon.
- Given his 20 years' experience developing software for investment and central banks in England, Luxembourg, France, Greece and West Africa, it is easy to see why he believes blockchain technology can change the world.
- A Founding Member of the UK Digital Currency Association a non-profit organisation created in London to establish a dialogue with regulators and government and to educate businesses, the public and regulatory bodies about digital currencies
- Since 2013, he has been a regular speaker at many bitcoin/blockchain conferences and events around the world. He is fluent in French and English, and is able to converse in Mandarin Chinese.
